TEACHER ASSESSMENT, SAT RESULTS AND REPORTS

As you may be aware, the children in Y2 and Y6 were assessed at the end of key stage and the results have been shared with their families in the annual reports.

The test results are reported using <u>scaled scores</u>, which range from 80-115 in KS1 and 80-120 in KS2, where 100 is defined as the 'expected standard'.

Expected standard

Last week, we sent home every child's annual report explaining their achievement this year. We are very proud of all of our pupils, as they demonstrated huge amounts of commitment and tried their very best. Please remember that tests do not assess all of what it is that makes each child special and unique. They do not reflect the values they have learnt and the learning dispositions they have developed which make them compassionate, resilient and responsible young people who care about their family and friends and the world in which they live. They are not able to show how the children have developed as leaders of the school.

Each of your children has been on their own journey over time and have made so much progress in so many different ways. We hope you enjoy reading their reports and seeing the results of their achievement this year. Be very proud of your child.

On **Monday 23rd July**, we will be having a music enrichment day – a drumming day.






CONGRATULATIONS TO THE WINNERS OF WORMLEY'S

Messy Church is a joint venture between the school and the Parish of Broxbourne and Wormley
























MUSIC LESSONS

SCHOOL DINNERS

Dinner money charges from September will be £2:45 per meal.

Dinner money letters will be sent out on the first day of the Autumn term and must be paid during the first week.



ALL children in Reception, Y1 and Y2 will be entitled to a universal free school meal.

Children in Year 3 or older:

Your child could be eligible for free school meal if you in receipt of one of the following benefits:

Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190

Your child may be entitled to free school meals and additional support in school, such as: reduced contributions to school trips; access to music lessons; access to holiday clubs and lunch/after school clubs; additional educational support; additional resources for learning
