In the following week, we will introduce a book which the whole school will read and study together and the children will take part in a week of inspirational maths.


Once again, we would like to thank families for supporting their children's learning from home. Staff are so pleased with the children who have tried so hard with on-line learning.

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Childcare Ch^oices

The Government has introduced some changes to the Childcare Voucher scheme.

If you are currently working for an employer that offers childcare vouchers then you can use them to pay for Breakfast & Afterschool Club. However the government has now introduced an alternative option called Tax-Free Childcare which is the new government scheme to help parents with the cost of childcare. It gives eligible families up to £2,000 free per child towards childcare costs and is designed to eventually replace the childcare vouchers. You can now use either scheme to pay for Breakfast & Afterschool Club.

To find out more about both schemes and to work out which may be better for you please visit the links below. Please note that you can only be a member of one scheme not both, if you and your partner currently have childcare vouchers then you need to make a joint decision as you cannot have one parent on the government scheme and another on the employer support childcare voucher scheme.
