

## Wormley C of E RE Curriculum Map 2021

### Notes for Parents

- The Statement of Entitlement states KS1 Must teach at least 10 hours of RE per term and KS2 must teach at least 13 hours of RE per term.
- Each year will begin with an exploration day; a time for that year group to explore their alternative World Religion to help children understand different beliefs and practices. This helps them to make comparisons between that religion and other world beliefs.
- Each year group will have a main focus on Christianity but also one other World Religion. This is informed by the demographics of our school and the most dominant religions in our local area.
- We teach from the Herts Agreed Syllabus which suggests the 'Big Questions' which we investigate with the children.
- These 'Big Questions' will be explored firstly through Christianity and then through the other World Religion for that year group.
