

SEN Information Report

Introduction

At Wormley Primary School, we are committed to the equal inclusion of all pupils in all areas of school life. We recognise the diverse and individual needs of all of our pupils and take into account the additional support required by those children with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND).

There are four broad areas of need:

- **Communication and Interaction**
This includes children with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and those with speech, language and communication needs (SLCN).
- **Cognition and Learning**
This includes children with specific learning difficulties (SpLD), moderate learning difficulties (MLD), severe learning difficulties (SLD) and profound and multiple learning difficulties (PMLD).
- **Social, emotional and mental health difficulties**
This includes children who have an emotional, social or mental health need that is impacting on their ability to learn.
- **Sensory and/or physical needs**
This includes children with hearing impairment (HI), visual impairment (VI), multi-sensory impairment (MSI) and physical difficulties (PD).

Our Special Educational Needs (SEN) Information Report, which is part of Hertfordshire's Local Offer, provides details about how we support children and young people with Special Educational Needs in our school.

The **SEN Information Report** was reviewed and updated in **July 2020**.
